Dog Control Policy

The Council's Dog Control Policy and Bylaw was reviewed in 2016.

Dog Control Practices

Council employs two Animal Control Officers, a part-time administrator and an after-hours contractor, South Otago Security Services. This provides a 24 hours, seven days a week dog control service. Animal Control Officers work between the hours of 8.30am to 5pm, five days a week.

Fees for the 2017/18 financial year were as follows:

Registration:

Urban - \$58

Rural - \$26

Responsible Dog Owner - \$26

Impounding fees:

First Offence - \$60

Second Offence - \$90

Third Offence - \$120

Sustenance - \$15 per day

Euthanasia - \$35 per dog

Microchipping - \$30 per dog
