Participant Terms and Conditions

1. Sort and collect the items that you no longer want and are happy to give away.
2. Identify a suitable and practical site on your property boundary – such as the driveway or next to your letter box – to place the items to be given away.
3. On Sunday between 9.00 am and 12.00 pm:
 - Display the poster on your letter box so people know you have items to give away.
 - Place items to be given away at the site no earlier than 9.00am.
 - Be there to keep an eye on what is happening and to meet local fossickers.
 - At noon take down the poster and take back any items left over – you are still responsible for any items that are not taken away. If it is left outside your property you will be in breach of the Clutha District Council Public Places Bylaw.
4. Exclusions:
 - No food or dangerous goods.
 - No chemicals, faulty electrical equipment, firearms or rubbish.
5. What to do with leftover items:
 - These can be put away again for the next Second-Hand Sunday or you may wish to consider other second-hand outlets. Consider the 5Rs of Refuse, Rethink, Reduce, Reuse and Recycle, for the greater goal of diverting waste to landfill.
6. If you are collection items:
 - Only collect items at households where the Second Hand Sunday poster is displayed.
 - Only collect items between the advertised hours – no earlier, no later. No door knocking please.
 - It is recommended to have electrical items that you collect checked to make sure they are safe.
 - Do not enter their properties – no one wants to trespass.

Disclaimer: I understand I am responsible for uncollected goods and will move them back inside if not collected by Noon. By my participation in the Second-Hand Sunday activities I agree to abide by the terms and conditions set out and that the Clutha District Council has no liability to any person for any loss of or damage to goods or for injury or death to person whether arising from negligence or otherwise and in any way caused by or connected with the Second-Hand Sunday activities. I agree that things such as food or dangerous goods like faulty electrical equipment, chemicals or firearms will be excluded from this activity.
