Communication to Council via Antenno

Would you like to be alerted to what's going on in your neighbourhood and beyond?

Antenno is a free mobile app that sends you notifications and alerts regarding water shutdowns, rubbish/recycling collection and community events.

You can also place service requests if you have noticed pot holes, water leakage, roaming dogs etc. Go to the 'Your Reports' menu and add a report which goes directly to the customer services team at the Clutha District Council.
