



# BERM TREES Information & Feedback Form

*We want your feedback on which trees need trimming and/or removal in Tapanui.*

The West Otago Community Board is continuing with beautification of Tapanui and Heriot with a focus on berm trees. The board has identified that a large number of berm trees in Tapanui are hanging over the footpaths and in some cases from inside an owner's property.

The board has identified a list of trees that require possible trimming, removal or replacement. They would like your feedback on the list and whether you agree or disagree with the trees and work identified. The berm report is detailed below:

Cemetery Road	Four trees need trimmed on left hand side going towards cemetery.
Durham Street	All trees need trimmed some hanging over the footpath. Also need the leaders trimmed off the trunks on the cherry trees.
Sussex Street	Silver Birch outside No 56 needs removing. All cherry trees need leaders trimmed off trunks. Four trees outside No 26 need removing. The trees outside No 37 need addressing in consultation with the owners. At No 3 Lincoln Street, remove the tree on the Sussex Street side of berm. Opposite No 22, a small tree needs removing. At the corner of State Highway and Forest Street a tree needs trimmed - particularly dangerous when coming out via the Sussex Street intersection on and looking towards Blue Mountain College.
York Street	No issues.
Park	Four trees that were planted need to be shifted and one needs to be replaced due to damage.
Northumberland Street	Small green area of dead tree needs tidied up. The trees at Farmlands need trimmed and the tree outside No 12 Station Road needs to be removed. The tree outside Seasons needs the dead branches taken off. The tree at the corner of Station Road needs looking at.
Norfolk Street	No issues.
Suffolk Street	No issues.
Essex Street	Tree outside the Plunket Rooms need trimmed, as hanging over the road.
Kent Street	Two Rowan trees opposite the Doctor's house need taking out and two Rowan trees outside the Police house need topped. The New Life Church trees need tidied up.
Sherwood Place	Silver Birch needs to be removed.
Dorset Street	No issues.
Forest Street	The big tree outside 20 Forest Street needs addressed as there are big roots on lawn.
Bushyhill Street	Tidy up or remove the tree in the park near No 40.
Mill Street	No issues.
Cambridge Street	No issues.
Tramway Street	Two trees on left hand side need removing and one tree needs trimmed on the left hand side.
Wood Street	No issues.
Pine Street	No issues.
Boundary Road	No issues.
Back Street	No berm trees.
Surrey Street	Trees need trimmed over footpath.
Bedford Street	No berm trees.
Derby Street	Take tree off at ground level and check the trees outside No 3 and No 1.
