THEME: LOCKDOWN

- 1. Open to all amateur and professional photographers who reside in the Clutha District,** however council staff and their families are not eligible.
- 2. Photos entered must have been taken inside the Clutha District.**
- 3. This is a digital photo competition only** (no prints).
- 4. Participants may enter up to two classes - their age class and the Devices class, with a maximum of 4 entries per class.**
Classes: A - Adult (19+)
 T - Teen (13-18)
 C - Child (5-12)
 D - Devices (phones, iPads etc, any age)
- 5. Awards.** Certificates will be awarded to all entrants in the Teens and Child classes, and to placegetters in the Adult and Devices classes.
Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 Champion Image - A2 print (donated by Clutha Print)
 and then framed (donated by Maxine Evans Art & Picture Framing Studio)
 Best of the Levels - Level 4, 3, 2, and 1 - Data Stick ea (donated by Johnstone Electrical)
 1st Classes A, T and D - 1 Years subscription to Clutha Camera Club (donated by Clutha Camera Club)
 2nd - (Clutha District Libraries)
 3rd -(Clutha District Libraries)
 1st Class C - Disposable camera and processing voucher (donated by Fantail Photos)
 2nd - (Clutha District Libraries)
 3rd - (Clutha District Libraries)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 6. All images must have been taken by a camera (film or digital) or device and been exposed by the entrant. All participants must own the Copyright of all photos entered.**
- 7. Images to have basic post processing only.** Cropping, minimal colour/density/contrast/sharpening adjustments are acceptable.

The following are NOT PERMITTED: No filters, HDR, vignetting, selective colouring, post processing with layers. No Triptych or Composite images. Entries in the Devices Class may not be cropped.

Images the judges feel don't follow these rules can be disqualified at their discretion.

8. **By entering this competition, all participants retain full ownership of photographs but the Clutha District Council reserves the right to use selected images without fee.**

9. **All images must be in jpeg/jpg format.**

10. **Images in the A, T and C classes must be a minimum of 1MB in size.**

11. **Entries are to be sent as a message (via Messenger) with photos attached (not embedded) to the CDC Libraries FaceBook site.** (There is a button for Messenger on the home page).

Photos sent by email are not permitted, and thumbdrives may NOT be dropped off at libraries.

12. **When entering, photos must be titled as follows:**

Class_Lockdown Level_Title of photo_Name of entrant_entry number.

(e.g. A_L3_Backyard Bliss_Frederick Dagg_01)

DO NOT put spaces either side of underscores as the file could get lost in the sort and not shown.

Entries can be in any level, e.g. 3 entries in level 4 and 1 entry in level 1.

Level 4: photo must have been taken between 26th March - 27th April

Level 3: photo must have been taken between 28th April -13th May

Level 2: photo must have been taken between 14th May - 8th June

Level 1: photo must have been taken between 9th June - July 31st
