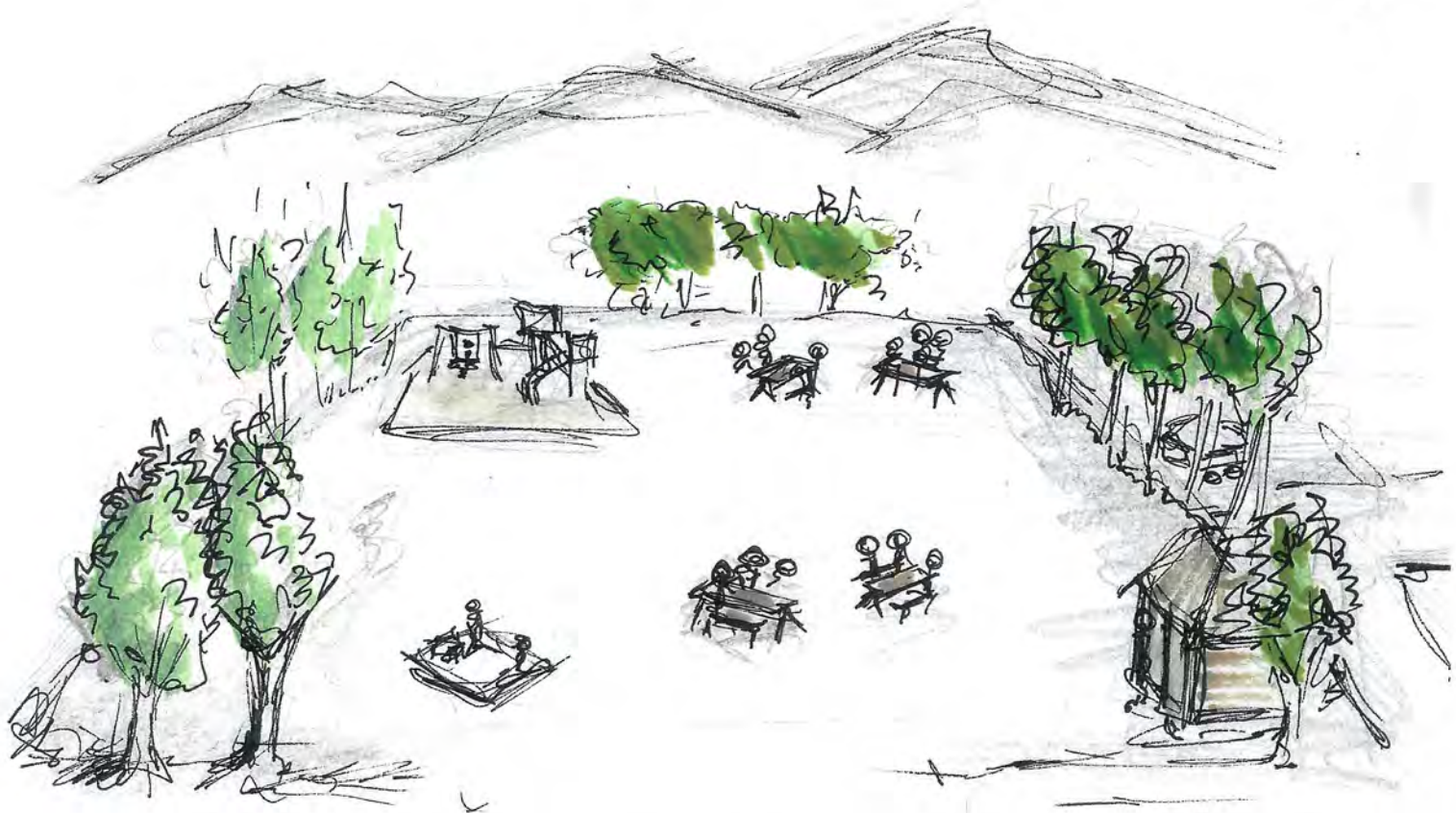


Student design workshop: Heriot

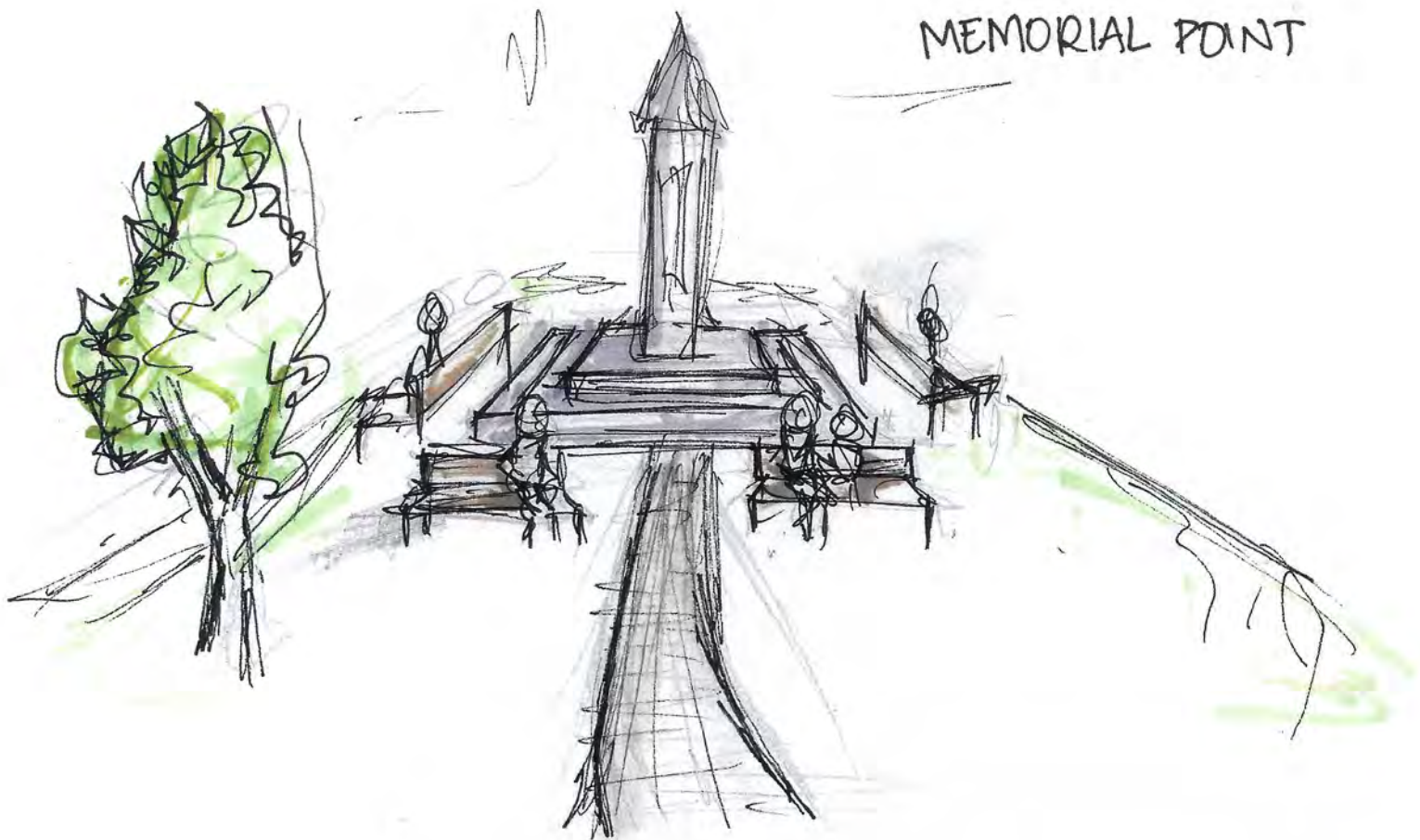

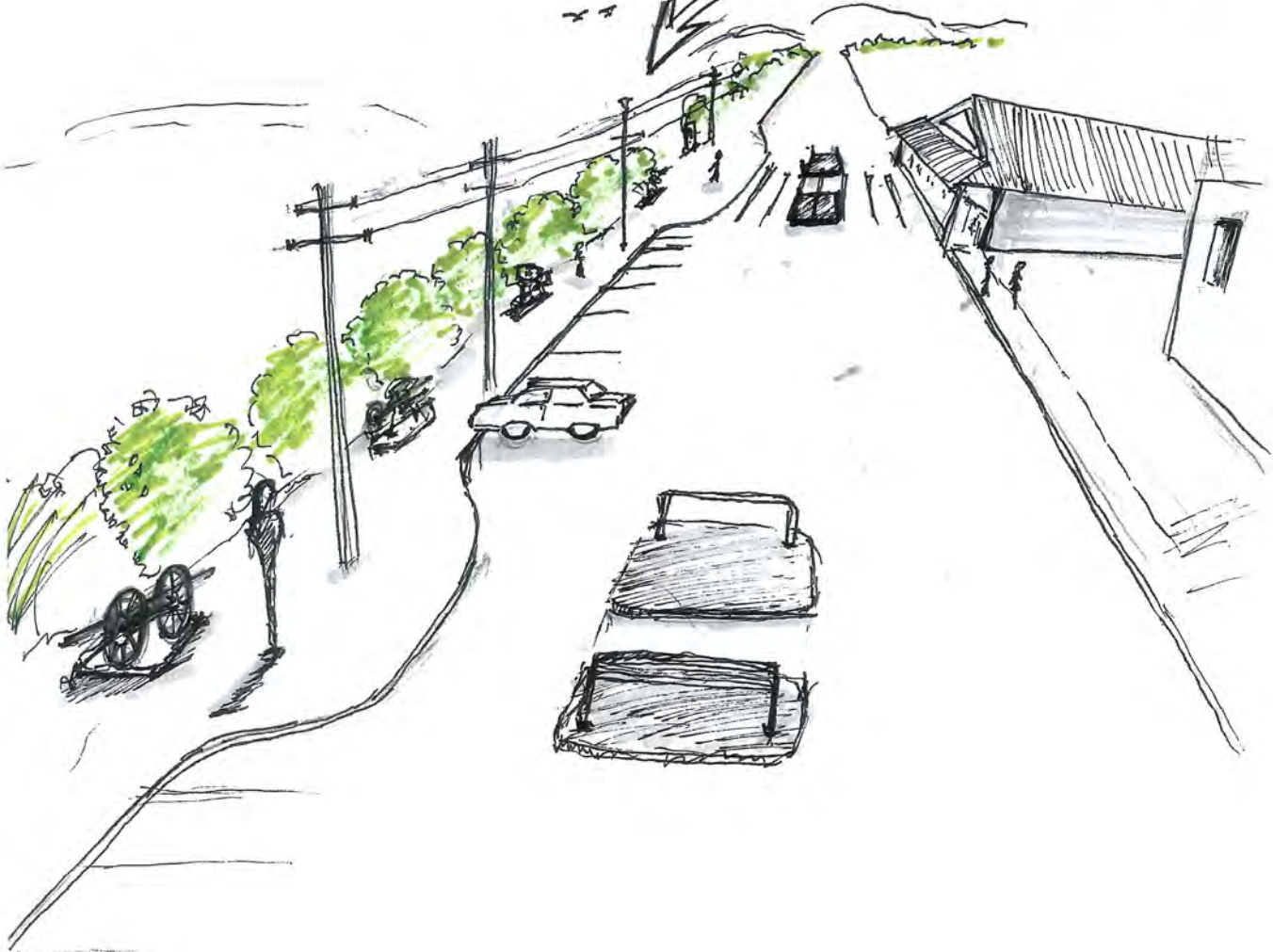


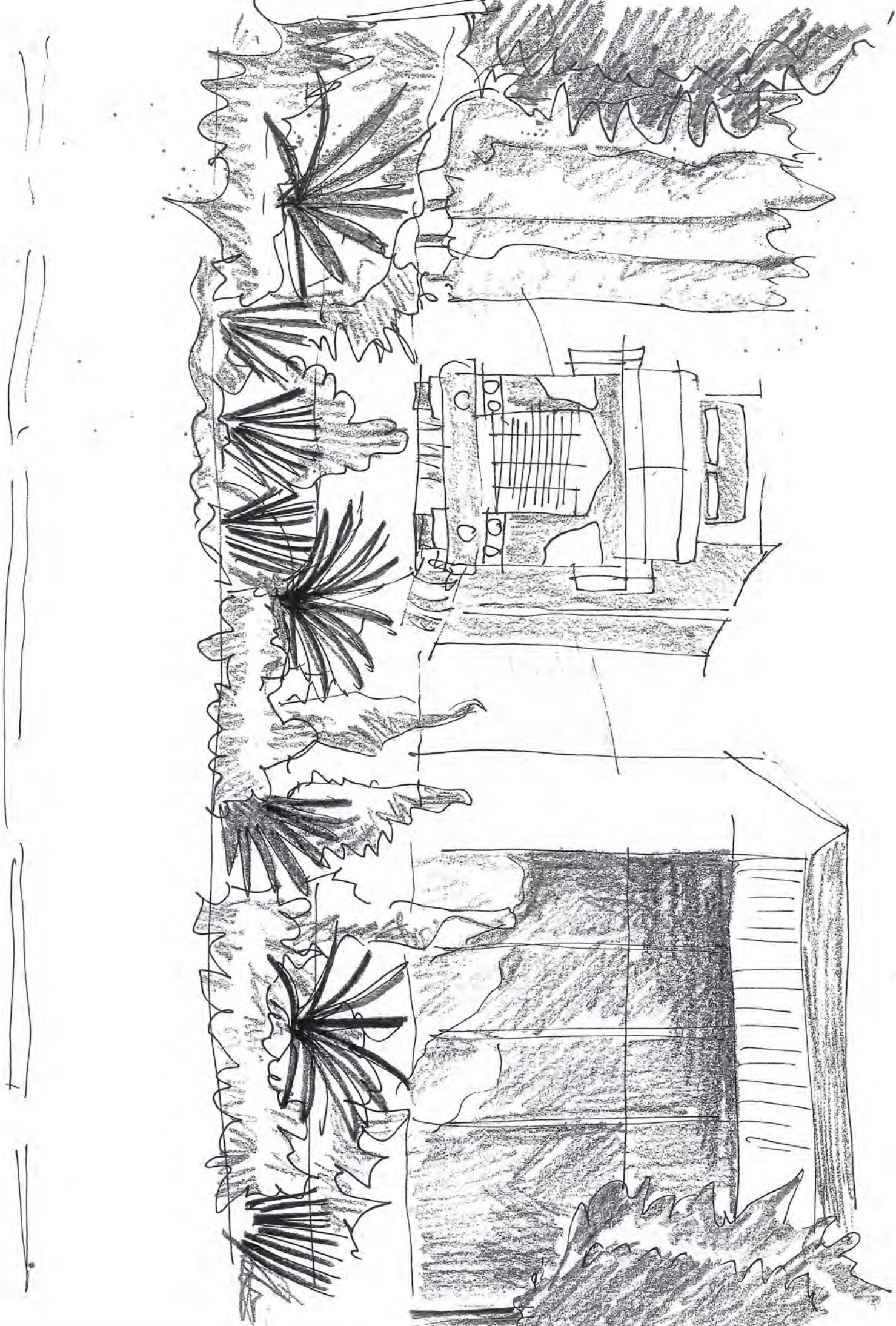
RECREATION AREA OFF ROXBURGH

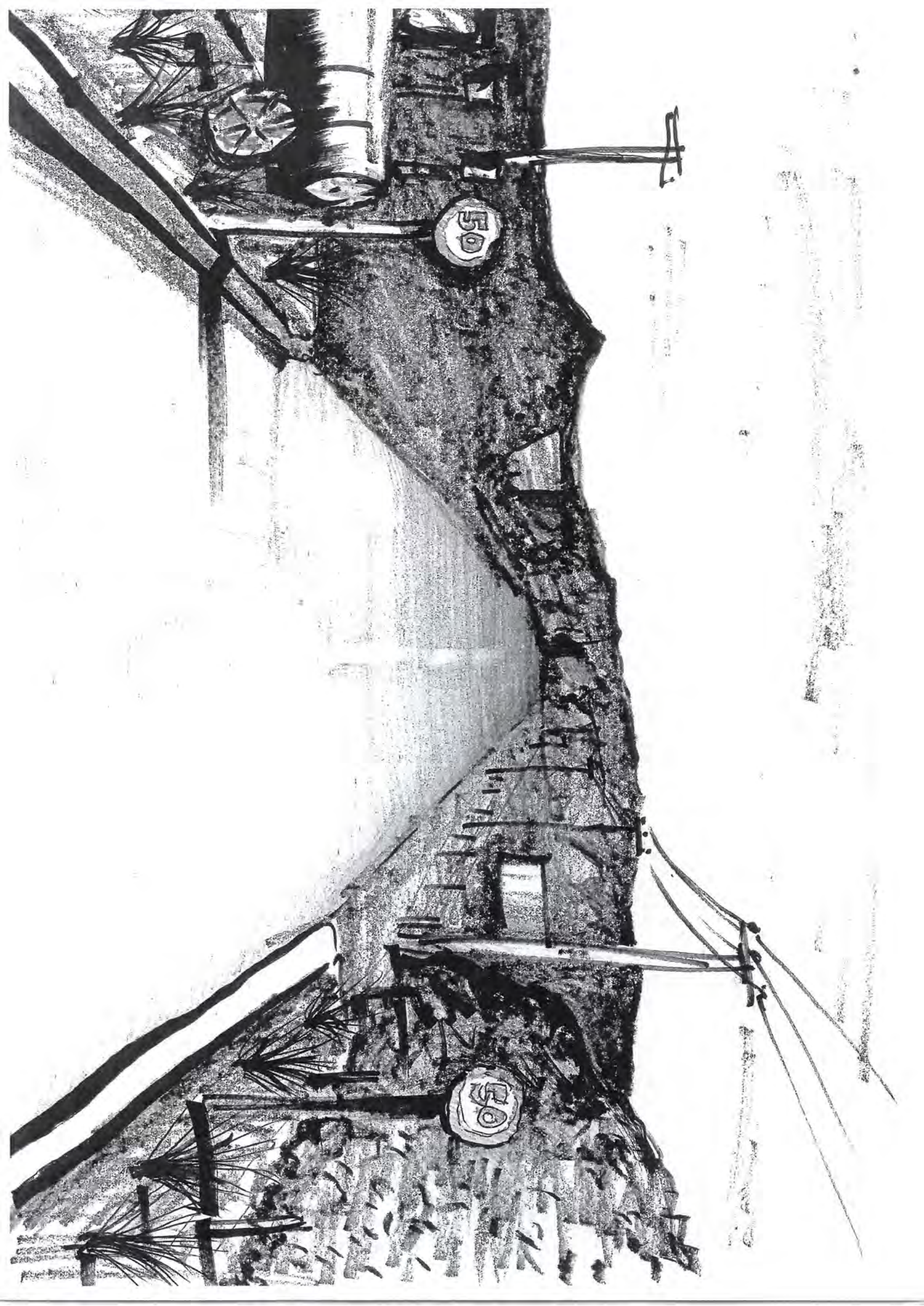

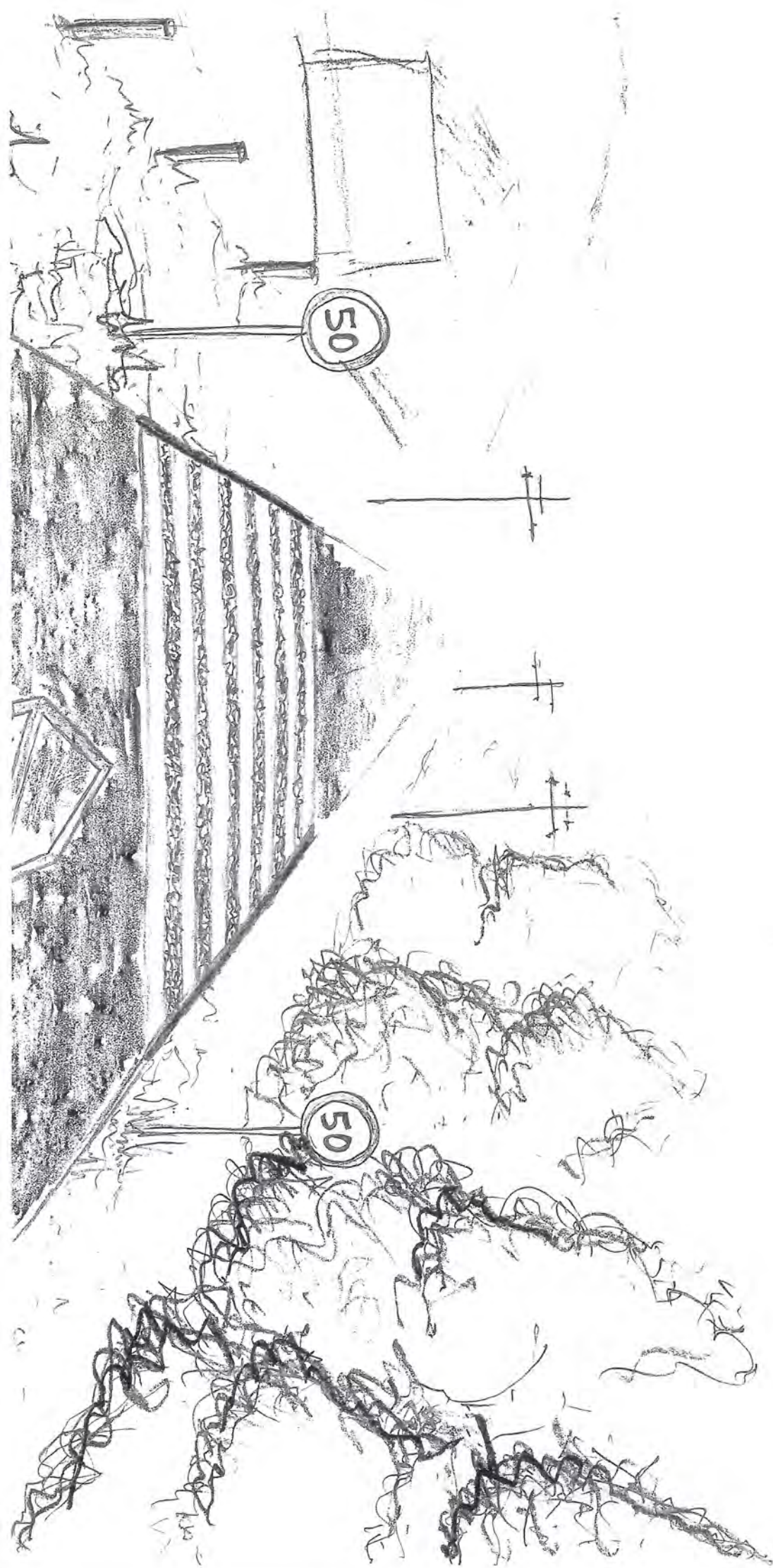




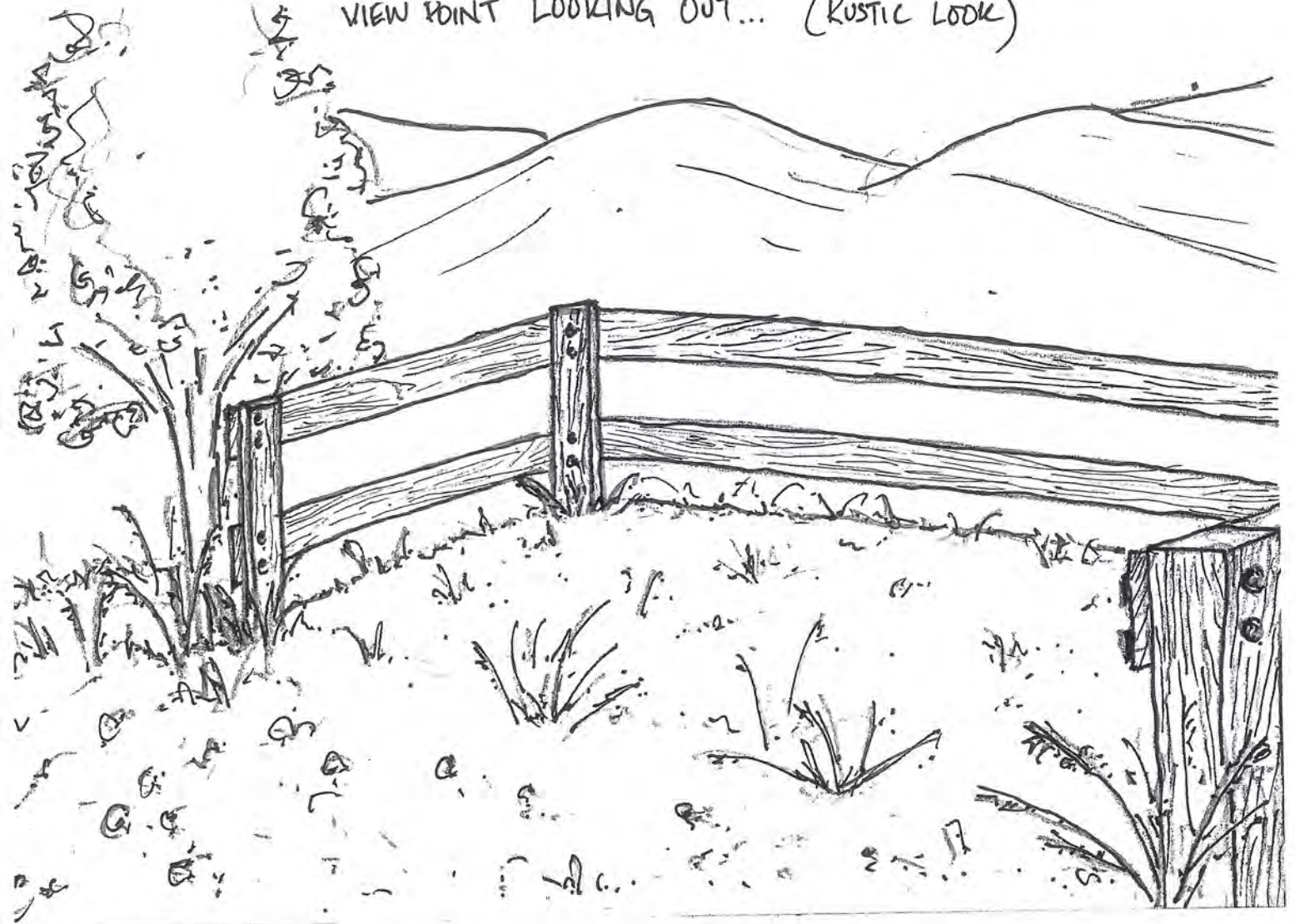






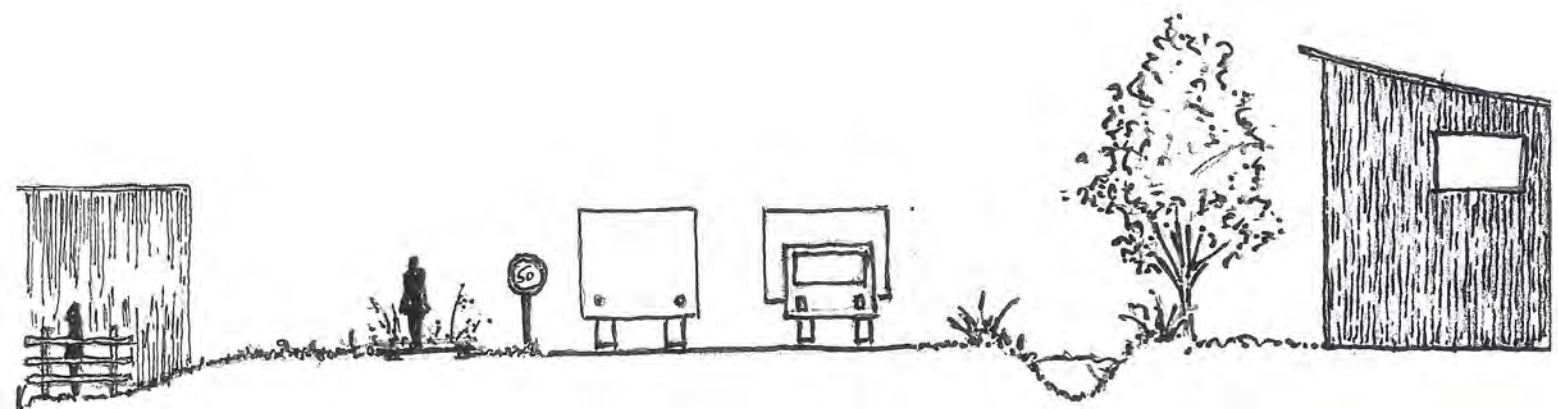


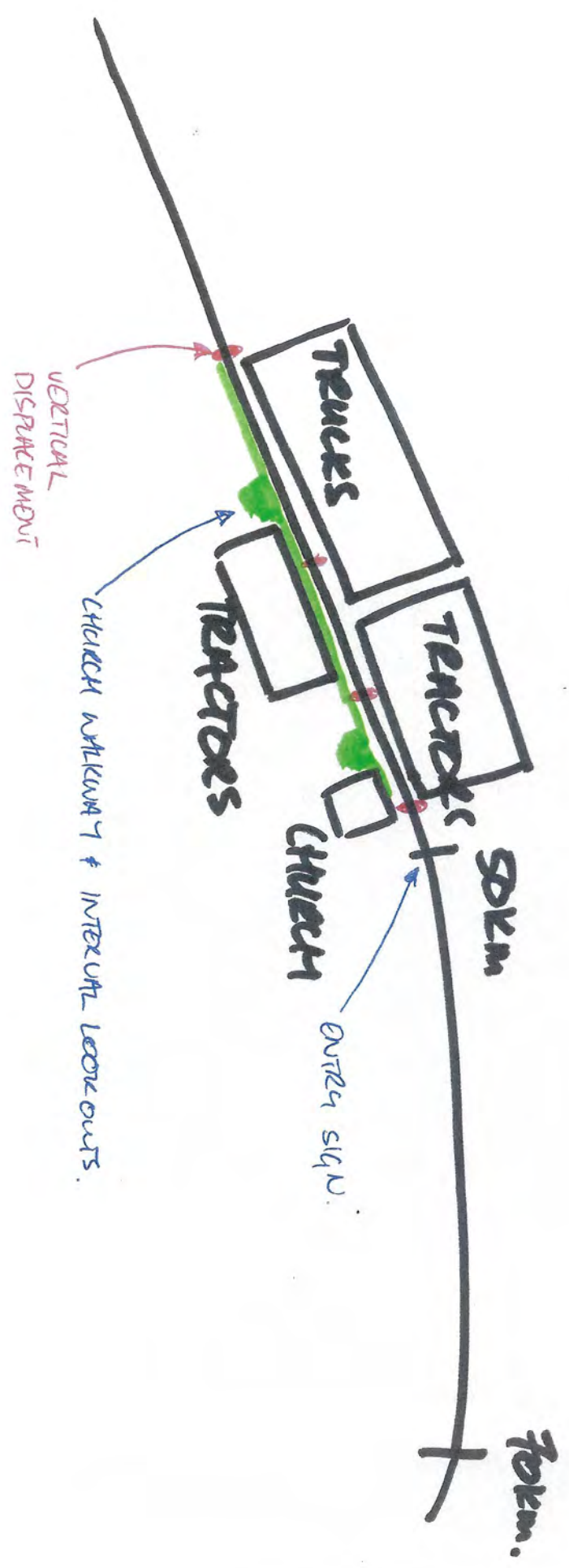
VIEW POINT LOOKING OUT... (RUSTIC LOOK)

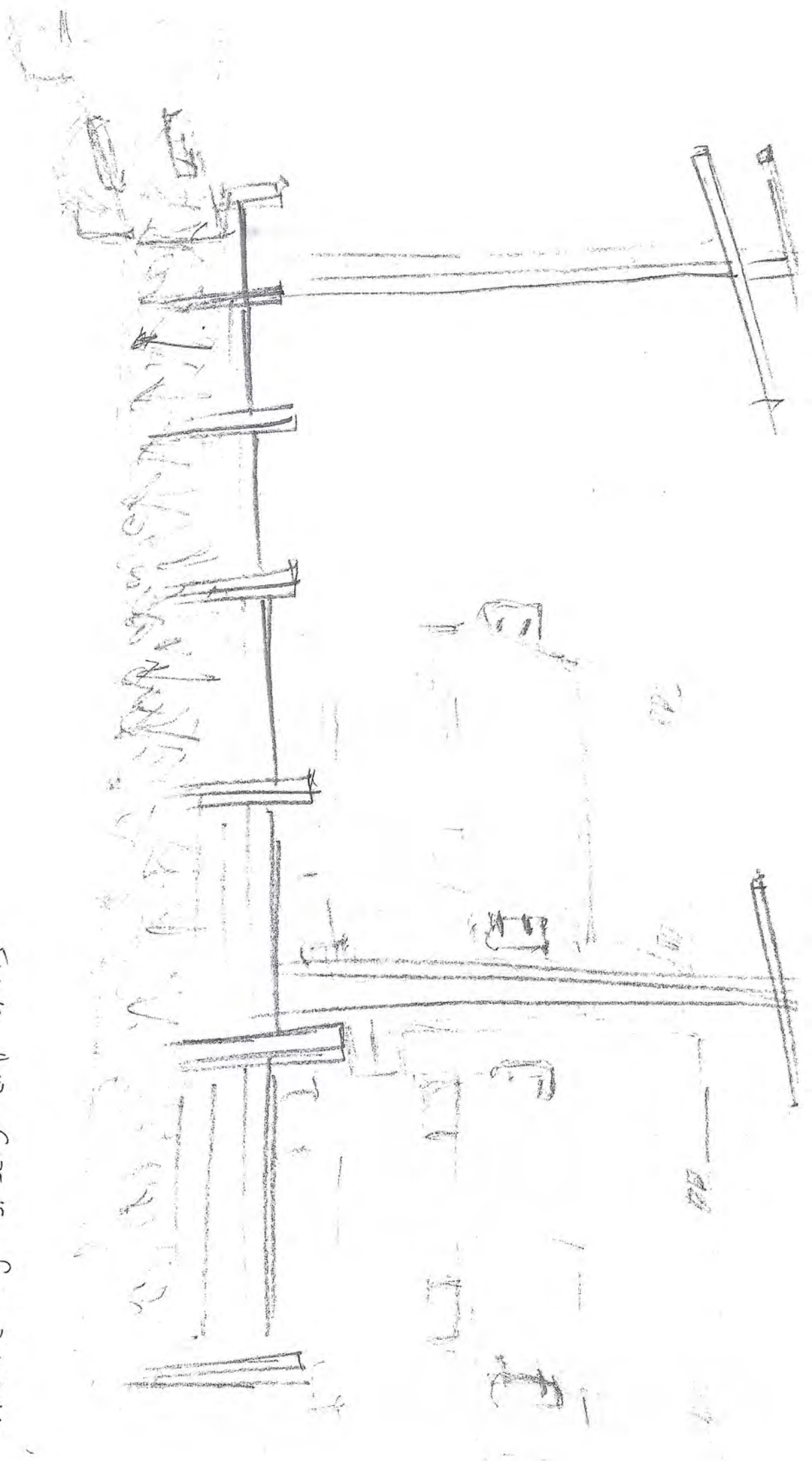


CROSS SECTION THROUGH THE MAIN ENTRANCE GATEWAY FROM GORE...

- Planting like Carex's, Red Oak's, Conifers etc...



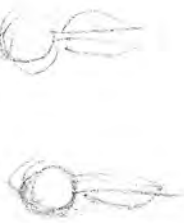
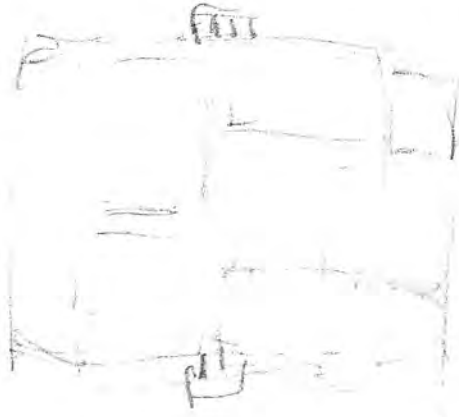
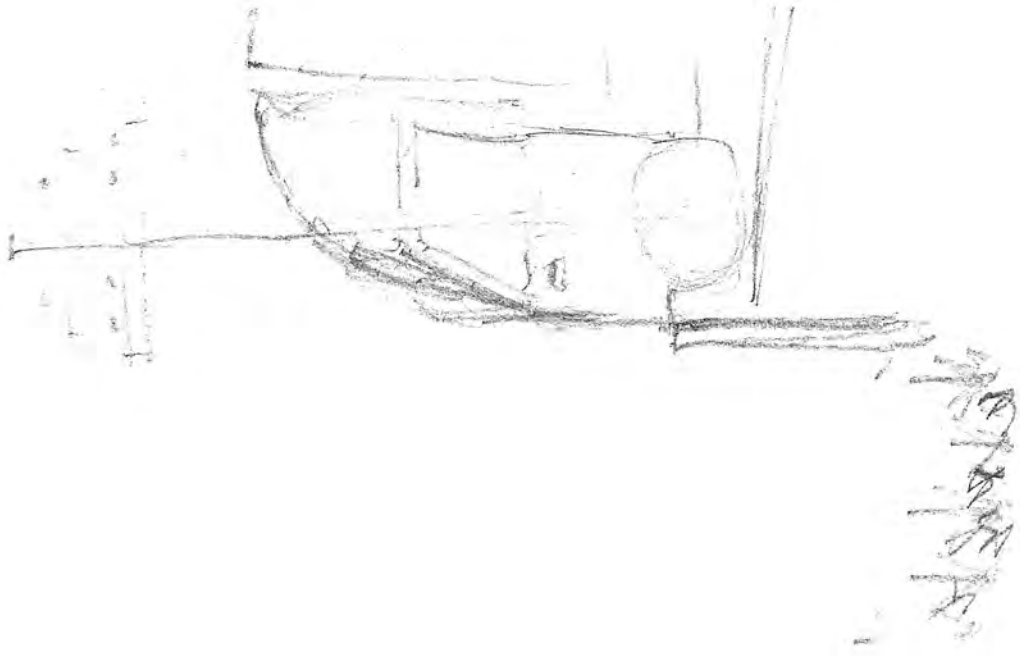




FLAX'S AND CAREX'S FOR PLANTING
